But all of this is about to change. There is a famine on the mainland of Tytonia, and the king of the Owl Parliament has long had his scheming eyes on the small colony to the north. Barry Wolverson weaves elements of Scandinavian folklore into this tale for readers 8 to 12." [The book] reads with the epic ambition of Watership Down, but with laughs.
