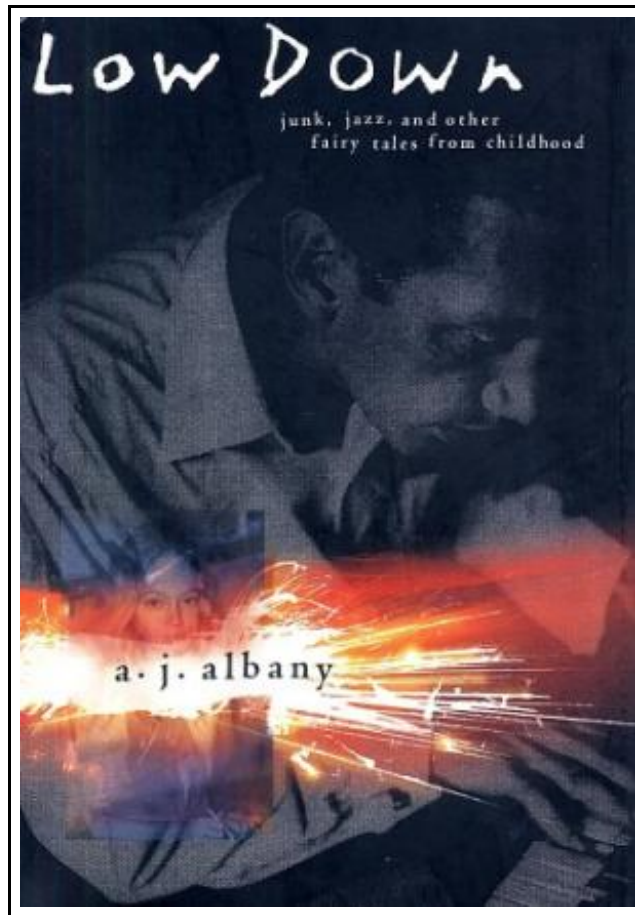

I kiss it, and say, Hi Monk. Dad, combusting with pride, picks me up, looks at me with those beautiful gray-green eyes, and says: From now on, you re not just my baby, you re my ace-one-boon-white-coon. That, he would claim, was the day we forever connected, and became more to each other than everything. So begins Amy Albany s life with her father, the legendary though obscure jazz pianist Joe Albany. Joe played with the likes of Charles Mingus, Lester Young, Charlie Parker, and Dexter Gordon. In red-boothed, booze-drenched Hollywood nightspots, chances were you d find Albany s daughter tucked behind the bar, curled on someone s fur coat, while her father played his set. Teddy bears were for other kids-Amy slept with a 78 of Louis Armstrong s Sugar Blues , and later with a photograph of the man himself inscribed To little Amy-Joe, always in love with you-Pops . Written with gritty honesty, Low Down is Amy Albany s extended improvisation on growing up, first appearing in Tin House Magazine, where it attracted the attention of Greil Marcus in his Real Life Rock Top Ten. Wise beyond her years and hip to the unpredictable ways of Old Lady Life at all too early an age, Albany guides us through the dope and deviance of the...
