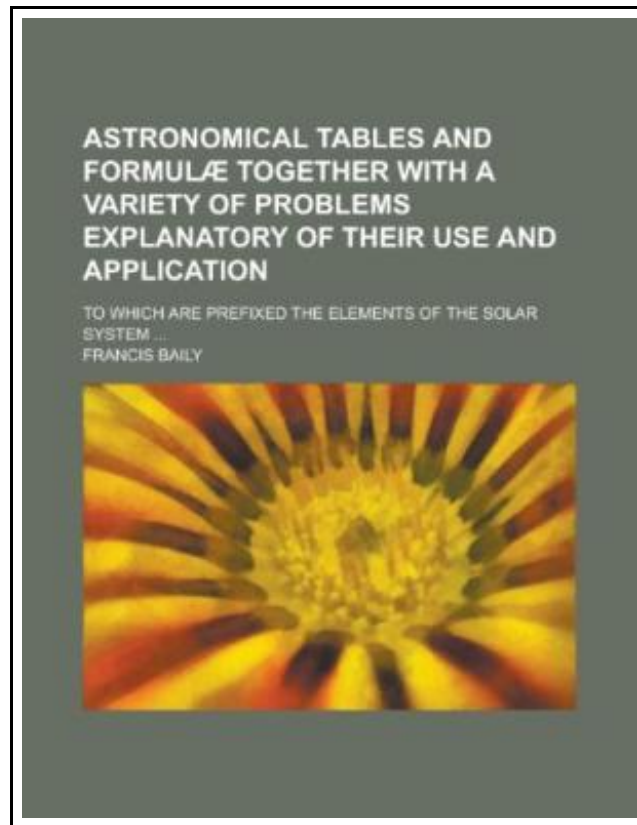

Excerpt: . . . practice of making observations on or near the prime vertical, it would be useful to have a table calculated to show the altitude of those stars which they usually observe in such case, and the time at which they pass the prime vertical. See Problem XIV. Tables XVIII and XIX are the well known tables for the reduction to the meridian, computed agreeably to the Formula XIX in page 93. The first of these tables shows $2 \sin 8 - P$ the value of $A - p$: and the argument of the table is the distance (in time) of the sun or star from the meridian. This value (or the sum of those values divided by the number of observations, if more than one observation has been made) must be multiplied by $7j$; Since $2 \sin 2 J P$ denotes the versed sine of the arc P , it is evident that the expression in the text is equal to $X \text{ ver. sine } P$. It is in this manner that the tables for the reduction to the meridian have been published by the Board of Longitude. They have printed a table of the versed sines of arcs from 0 to 30m of time, and direct that the arithmetical complement of the logarithm of $\sin 1$ be added to the constant logarithm (with its index increased by 4) of the number by which the result is multiplied: thus increasing the trouble and the liability to error.
